## Qumran Yields New Secrets 2005 Dig Report

The 2005 dig marked a new turning point in the Qumran Plateau Excavation Project being conducted with the Geophysical, Historical, and Religious Roots Amuta in Israel. From a small dig in 2002 the site of the Dead Sea Scrolls community has grown to the status of a major excavation in size, scope, and importance. This year the dig explored an area next to the ancient settlement's eastern wall, which separates it from the community's cemetery with over 1,000 graves. The section of wall at the point of our excavation was collapsed and appeared to have been so from the past – but when and why? Our dig revealed the answer: a large man-made circular pit that had been abandoned and filled in the time of the Hasmoneans (a half-century or more before the birth of Jesus). Uncovering this 2,000 year-old pit with its rich archaeological fill required careful skill on behalf of our team and discovering its original purpose will occupy scholars for years to come. Another first for our team has been the extensive mapping of the site employing computer technology and aerial photography (from a camera-mounted dirigible). We are now able to see our excavation in context with the entire ancient community, which was excavated in the 1950's.

In the first-century level above the pit the remains of a stone installation with ancient ashes still intact was

discovered along with a coin helping date the level of occupation. Nearby were several other installations including a cooking oven (tabun) with pottery deposits filled with or covering animal bones. These are the same type of animal bone burials discovered in previous years that have long been judged to have been the remains of communal meals shared by the community. In the southern area of our site were uncovered more than 40 separate burials of the bones of bulls, sheep and goats. This large assemblage of bones, many bearing butchering marks and still in articulation (attached together) has enabled us to make new observations about these mysterious burials.

For one, a cursory examination seems to reveal the absence of hip-bones, a part of the animal traditionally avoided by observant Jews. This practice resulted from the wrestling contest between Jacob (Israel) and the Angel of the Lord during which

Jacob's hip was dislocated. In Genesis 32:32 we read: "Therefore, to this day the sons of Israel do not eat the sinew of the hip which is on the socket of the thigh, because he touched the socket of Jacob's thigh in the sinew of the hip." If this proves to be the case it may add additional support to these burials being conducted by members of a pious, priestly community such as has been

### The Significance of the Qumran Excavations for Christians

*Set in time between the Old and New Testaments, the site of Qumran saw both the birth of Jesus and the birth of the Christian Church. ## Seasons Greetings from the World of the Bible!

I have often marveled at how the Lord timed the birth of His Son to serve as the climax of Israel's fall festivals. Whether or not He was born in the winter or the spring (as some scholars contend), His birth came after the great celebrations of the Day of Atonement and Passover, which remember God's gracious acts of deliverance spiritually and physically, and of Tabernacles, which recall God's care until His promise to enter the Land was completed and which looked forward to the Gentiles finding the God of Israel as their savior. Truly the embodiment and realization of that salvation came as Jesus the Messiah made His entrance into this world at Bethlehem! Is it not fitting that the celebration of His coming at this season should follow and climax all of these other celebrations?

Sadly, however, in this season of rejoicing over the reality of Christ's birth there are those who believe His very existence was a myth, or else that the Church invented a divine Christ. Dan Brown's popular work of fiction (called by him "fact") *The DaVinci Code* is such an example (discussed on page 7 of this newsletter). Even in Christendom (that ecumenical hodge-podge of everything called "Christian") there are many denominations who accept Jesus birth (as the rest of His life) as only a symbol of "the universal child" or of a humanistic spirit of "goodwill toward all men." Some even wonder if the world of the Bible itself is a real. Just last night I had dinner with an Israeli who works in the airline industry who told me of his experience with someone like this. In a recent telephone survey he was asked where he was born, and when he replied "Jerusalem," the caller stated in a surprised voice, "You mean there really is such a place?" Yes, for many the Christ of Christmas, as well as the Land of Israel, is just a fairy tale!

Our purpose at World of the Bible Ministries is to proclaim in our confused culture the real Jesus in the real world of the Bible, for only by knowing the One who was really born in Bethlehem and really died and rose again in Jerusalem can there be real salvation. Our faith does not save us, the object of our

faith saves us and our salvation can only be as sure as the reality of the One in whom we have trusted. For this reason we work hard to make the biblical world come alive through archaeological endeavor, to encourage the Church to realize God's continuing plan for the Jewish people and to understand the current conflict in the Middle East as part of this plan for Israel's final redemption through the written word, media productions, teaching in schools and seminaries, and prophetic conferences around the world.

thought to be at Qumran.

Other new insights concerning these bone burials has been the fact that bones along with ashes were stored in both intact and broken vessels and the discovery of stone markers, cut from imported rock, placed next to a number of the deposits. In one example a ritual dish was found with the bone deposit and in another intact pots filled with bone and ash covered by other intact pots or jars. Some of the pottery represented unique pieces rarely - if ever - discovered in similar period excavations in the region! Barbara Johnson,

one of the world's experts in the pottery of this area, has been contracted to analyze all of the pottery found to date this winter and will issue a report to us sometime this spring.

In 2004, a repository (?) was discovered with a winding passageway, storage areas, and steps leading down from the ancient surface level to the passageway. This repository (?) was located *below* an oven (tabun) and a number of bone burials. The floor into which the passageway had been cut was marked with evidence of the earthquake that had destroyed the first phase of the community in 31 B.C. and the passageway and storage areas had

been filled with fine dune sand. The storage areas, usually small circular pits cut in the floor to hold jars or larger hollows cut into the sides of the passageway, contained large pieces of broken pottery (sherds), indicating that the area had once been used to hold (or hide?) pottery vessels. Following the passageway to the west this past season revealed more of the repository and a new set of steps leading downward. Coming to light at the very end of the dig restricted us further exploration of the passageway, which continued beyond the limits of our excavation area.

Our 2006 season, June 19-July 27,

will finally explore the rest of this mysterious repository, uncover a new area of extensive bone burial in the south next to the area discovered this year, and excavate the northern region of the site which ground-penetrating radar has indicated contains many anomalies (unknown objects). Volunteers can expect a rich time of discovery and experience the thrill of being the first to touch artifacts last handled by Israelites while the ancient Temple stood in Jerusalem! ## Dr. Price answers your questions

We encourage you to send Dr. Price your questions. He will answer those that he feels most significant to our newsletter audience.

### Can we know the time of Christ's return?

The *exact* time of Christ's return has been set but is known only by God the Father. Jesus in the days of His flesh was under the authority of the Father and therefore did not know this time. Neither do the angels in heaven know the time (Matthew 24:36; Mark 13:32) because they are also subject to divine authority and to the elect as "ministering spirits to those who will inherit salvation" (Hebrews 1:14). According to 1 Timothy 6:15 God the Father will bring about the second coming of Christ at "the proper time," just as He brought Him into the world at the first coming (Galatians 4:4). Therefore, we do not need to be concerned about the exact time but can rest in the assurance that it will be at the right time! Having said this, we can, and should, be able to discern the *approximate* time of Christ's coming from the teaching of Scripture.

Jesus admonished the Pharisees and Sadducees concerning their discernment of coming of the Messiah: "Do you know how to discern the appearance of the sky, but cannot discern the signs of the times?" (Matthew 16:3). Although this referred to the time of Jesus' first coming, it can be applied also to the time of His second coming. Since believers are told to wait "for His Son from heaven" (1 Thessalonians 1:10) it must be possible to discern when the time of Christ's coming is getting closer. Paul said: "knowing the time, that it is already the hour for you to awaken from sleep, for now salvation is nearer to us than when we believed. The night is almost gone, and the day is at hand..." (Romans 13:11-12a). By understanding the prophetic plan it is possible to discern the times in which we live and how close we are to the time of His coming. While, as Paul reminded, the coming of the

Lord is nearer every day, there is also a discernable progression in the world – and especially with Israel – that enables us to understand that we are closer to the time in this generation than ever before.

The key to recognizing the approximate time of Christ's return is the recognition that the Second Coming has two distinct phases – one that occurs *in the air* and is for the ultimate *salvation of the Church* and one that is *on the earth* and is for the *redemption of Israel* and the *judgment of the nations*. These contrasts (as well as some 30 more given in my book *Charts of Bible Prophecy*) require us who are part of the Church in this age to look for first phase of Christ's return known as "the Rapture" (after the Latin word that translates the Greek word *harpadzo* "caught up" in 1 Thessalonians 4:17). The second phase, which is known as "the Revelation" (Greek, *apocalypsis*) since it is a revealing of Christ to the whole world, follows the first phase by a period of seven years (Matthew 24:21-22, Luke 21:24 with Revelation 11:2), a time after the Church has already been translated to heaven.

While there are no signs that precede the coming of Christ for the Church (the Rapture), there are many definite signs that precede the coming of Christ to earth (the Revelation). Just as one may say when they see turkeys and pumpkins in the stores in the fall that Christmas is coming (since Thanksgiving precedes Christmas) so events associated with the world and Israel that may be preparing for the Tribulation (which precedes the Revelation of Christ) may reveal to us that the signless event of the Rapture is near (since the Rapture of the Church precedes the Revelation of Christ).

Even though we can only know an approximate time and not the exact time, we are still to be ready all the time! Titus 2:13 says that we should

be looking for "the Blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Christ Jesus." The "Blessed hope" refers to the Rapture and the "glorious appearing" is the Revelation, and both are events that should be "looked for" by the believer. The concept expressed here is that of readiness to meet Christ, a spiritual attitude that enables us to live in this world without being worldly (Titus 2:12) and a focus that purifies our lives (1 John 3:3). Because the Rapture could occur at any time, we should be ready all the time. Therefore, even though we cannot know exactly when Christ will return, we can be prepared for His coming whenever it will occur. Even so, passages like 1 Thessalonians 5:6 refer to the Revelation of Christ and encourage us to be "alert to the Day of the Lord." This does not mean that the Church will be on earth when this event occurs but that since the ungodly will be judged in that day, believers are to use this fact as a motivation for godliness at the present hour. A similar exhortation to godliness is made in light of the more distant "destruction of the heavens and earth" in 2 Peter 3:14-15, an event that takes place a thousand years after Christ has returned to earth and established His messianic reign. Therefore, as we see the day of Christ drawing near we must be sure we ourselves have trusted Christ as Savior and then warn others to come to Christ before He comes!

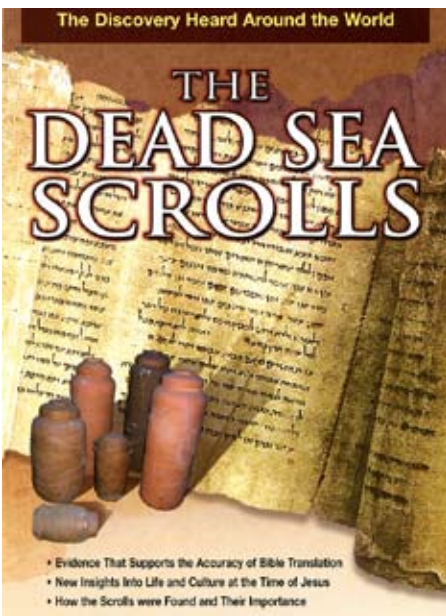

# Report from Jerusalem

Here in Jerusalem we are told that we live in the “center of the world” (Ezekiel 5:5; 38:12). Whether or not we are in the geographical center of the globe, the whole world certainly has an eye on what happens here!

Sometimes, too, the world comes to Jerusalem, as in the case of the recent best-selling novel by Dan Brown, *The DaVinci Code*. This book has claimed that Christianity is a dangerous fraud, that the church at the 4th century Council of Nicea invented the concept of original sin and Jesus’ divinity, that his real life included marriage to Mary Magdalene who was one of his disciples but turned into a prostitute by the church. Brown also states that the church launched a smear campaign against paganism, defaming goddess worship and recasting pagan beliefs as “evil,” but nothing in Christianity he says is original but copied from paganism. In fact, he claims, there were more than 80 gospels considered for the New Testament, but only the few selected by the pagan emperor Constantine make up the modern Christian Bible.

Moreover, he says that during a one hundred year witch-hunt the church burned more than five million women at the stake. But, then, who

really believes such statements, since everyone knows that this novel is a work fiction? Unfortunately, this is not the case, because Brown declared in the beginning of his novel: “All descriptions of artwork, architecture, documents, and secret rituals in this novel are accurate.” Contending that his views are based upon fact presents a formidable challenge to those who attempt to present the truth of Jesus as Israel’s Messiah and the formation of the early church from within Judaism. Israelis are voracious readers and Brown’s book is prominently showcased in most bookstores (which are on almost every corner in Jerusalem and in every city throughout the country).

Already predisposed against Christianity the Israeli public has had their worse misconceptions and fears reinforced by Brown’s engaging assault on history and faith. Brown is even considered to be a “Christian” by most Israelis! With the soon release of the motion picture version of the *DaVinci Code*, produced by Ron Howard (Opie on *The Andy Griffith*

*Show*), these twisted “truths” will be given an added realism to the Israeli movie-goer which includes just about everyone and especially the gullible youth culture.

The work of World of the Bible Ministries continues to respond to such error by showing the real Jesus of history and the facts about the Gospels as revealed in the archaeological record and a correct understanding of the first-century context of His life and ministry. Through the knowledge of the world of the Bible *The DaVinci Code* will be seen for the fictitious mockery that it is.

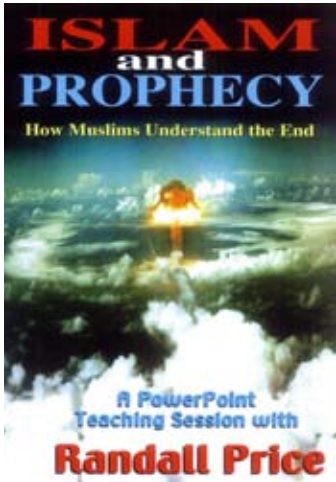

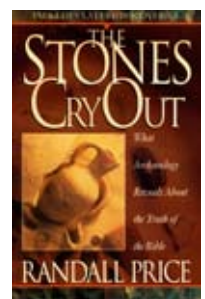
